From our new President, Pam McGhee:

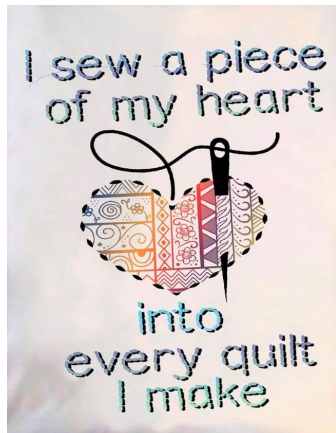

We also make fabric bags the Mom's can "shop" with in the HCWC store.
